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COMPARATIVE REVIEW ON ROLE OF DIFFERENT TYPES OF KSHARA SUTRA IN THE MANAGEMENT OF BHAGANDARA

ABSTRACT

Shalya Tantra is vital aspect of ancient medical science of India that is Ayurveda, the literatures available from Sushruta's time encompasses information related to the surgical or para-surgical approaches of Ayurveda. Ayurveda Shalya Tantra described management of different pathological conditions which require surgical or para-surgical care and Bhagandara (Fistula in ano) is one of them. It is considered amongst Ashta Mahagadas due to its severity and frequency of prevalence. The management of Bhagandara through various approaches of Shalya Tantra is well established and application of Kshara Sutra is one such approach which offers remarkable effects in the management of Bhagandara. There are various types of Kshara Sutra available now a day's those can be employed for treating condition like; Bhagandara, considering this present article reviewed role of different types of Kshara Sutra in the management of Bhagandara. This article definitely explore new path in this area for upcoming researchers.

INTRODUCTION

Shalya Tantra as a stream of Ayurveda described management of various diseases including Anorectal disorders. Bhagandar is one such disease which needs surgical or para-surgical attentions. In this regards Ayurveda philosopher presented uses of Kshar sutra as a medicated thread which can provides relief in pathological condition like Bhagandar. The Kshar sutra mainly coated with drugs and posses alkaline property. It is believed that Kshar Sutra dissolves fibrous tissues, helps to drain

pus and improves process of granulation in the damaged ano-rectal tract therefore offers beneficial effects in the management of ano-rectal disorders. *Bhagandar* are mainly three types; *Vataj Bhagandar*, *Pittaj Bhagandar* and *Kaphaj Bhagandar*, specific features of different types of *Bhagandar* mentioned in Table No.1.

As mentioned above the ano-rectal problem like *Bhagandara* imparts severe painful and chronic manifestation therefore its effective management is prerequisite. The *Ksharasutra* as para-surgical modality employed mainly for the management of such conditions. General mechanism of *Kshar Sutra* in ano-rectal problems depicted in Figure No.1.

Different types of *Ksharasutra* available for treating ano-rectal problems including *Apamarg Ksharasutra*, *Snuhi Haridra Ksharasutra* and *Guggulu*-based *Ksharasutra*, etc. Present article reviewed and summarizes role of these *Ksharasutra* in the management of *Bhagandara*.

Apamarg Ksharasutra

It is mainly prepared from latex of *Snuhi*, *Apamarga Kshar* and threads, etc. after preparation is subjected for sterilization. It should be stored in aseptic condition while rendered pH alkaline. *Apamarg Ksharsutra* facilitates healing of tract and alkaline characteristic of *Ksharsutra* imparts beneficial effects of chemical cauterization in *Bhagandara*. The ingredients of *Ksharasutra* offers combined effect in cutting and healing of fistulous tract.

PROBABLE MODE OF APAMARG KSHARASUTRA

The major advantage of *Apamarg Ksharasutra* is that it does not harm sphincter. *Ksharsutra* divides fibers of sphincter gradually and repair them simultaneously, this effect allow easy passing of *Ksharsutra* without complete dissection therefore damage of sphincter not occur. Moreover *Ksharsutra* causes lysis of abnormal tissues thus facilitates drainage, reduces microbial load, relieves pain due to its anti-inflammatory effect and promotes healing through granulation. The properties of ingredients such as; *Katu* and *Kashaya Rasa, Ushna Virya* and *Katu Vipak* helps to pacifies vitiated *Doshas* and prevent pathological progression of wounds/cuts.

Snuhi Haridra Ksharasutra:

It is prepared from surgical linen thread, latex of *Snuhi* and *Haridra powder*. The preparation involves coatings of *Snuhi-Ksheer* after mixing with *Haridra* powder. Stored in air tight aseptic condition after proper drying and sterilization. *Snuhi Haridra Ksharasutra* helps to drainage of pus, reduces itching and improves healing process. *Snuhi Ksheera Sutra* suggested for the management of recurrent fibrosed associated with *Bhagandara*.

PROBABLE MODE OF SNUHI HARIDRA KSHARASUTRA

Rakta Shodhaka, Vatahara and Vishaghna effects of ingredients of Snuhi Haridra Ksharasutra helps to suppress pathogenesis of Bhagandara. Vrana Ropana and Shodhana effects of Snuhi Haridra Ksharasutra promote healing and repairing process. Rasa, Katu Vipaka and Ushna Tikta resulted Kapha-Pitta Shamaka properties therefore helps to relieve symptoms and pathogenesis of Kapha and Pitta Bhagandara. Shothahara effect reduces inflammatory symptoms like pain, burning sensation and swelling.

Guggulu Ksharsutra

Surgical linen thread, *Haridra* powder and purified *Guggulu* mainly employed for the preparation of *Guggulu Ksharsutra*.

Guggulu based Ksharasutra offer Lekhana effect thus helps to reduces inflammation and believed to improve quality of life of patient so he/she can perform daily routine work without any difficulty. Literature suggested that Guggulu based Ksharasutra used partial when with fistulectomy then it reduces discharge, itching and facilitates drainage of pus thus improves natural healing process. Guggulu-based Ksharasutra impart analgesic and anti-inflammatory actions therefore reduce swelling or edema. However application of this Ksharasutra in ano-rectal conditions is very rare as compared to others.

Probable mode of action of Guggulu based Ksharasutra

Tridoshaghna property of ingredients believed to alleviate vitiated Dosha, Guggulu exerts Krimighna, Vrana Shodhaka and Ropaka effects

therefore improves healing process and restrict pathological progression of wounds associated with microbial contamination. It is reported that *Guggulu*-based *Ksharasutra* causes excision of fistulous track, helps to clean infected part and relieve symptoms of pain and inflammation.

Application of Ksharsutra

Lithotomy position of patient considered best for *Ksharsutra* application, *Ksharasutra* should be applied into the tract under the influence of anaesthesia, it is important to maintain aseptic condition while using *Ksharsutra*. Sterilized metal probe can be employed to insert *Ksharsutra* carefully under the supervision of expert physician. As postoperative care patient should be advised to take only liquid or semi solid diet to avoid any complications.

The general health benefits of *Kshar Sutra* in case of *Bhagandar* are as follows

Improves healing process

Pus drainage

Relive in pain and burning sensation

Healing and symptomatic relief achieved simultaneously

It dissolves fibrous tissues

Helps to improves process of granulation

Advantages of Kshar Sutra

Fewer chances of complications

Low recurrence frequency

Economic and easy to uses

Easily available since raw materials procurement is not very cumbersome process

No adverse effects with threads or raw materials Minimal invasion

CONCLUSION

Shalya Tantra is surgical stream of Ayurveda which described management of different surgical problems including Bhagandara. The Ayurveda Shalya Tantra utilizes various modalities to treat condition like Bhagandara and in this regards uses of Kshara Sutra presented in many literatures. There are various types of Kshara Sutra reported in case of Bhagandara; Apamarg Ksharasutra, Snuhi Haridra Ksharasutra and Guggulu-based Ksharasutra are some of them. Itching and pus discharge is the prominent feature of Kaphaj Bhagandar. Present literary study suggested that *Snuhi Ksharsutra* helps to reduces itching and facilitate pus discharge thus can be used effectively in Kaphaj Bhagandar. Apamarg Ksharsutra improves healing of ano-rectal tract & chemical cauterization relives symptoms of Bhagandar. Literature suggested that Guggulu based Ksharasutra when used with partial fistulectomy then it reduces discharge, itching and facilitates drainage of pus thus improves natural healing process. Finally article concluded that there is need of more research study in this area to standardize Ksharasutra as unique drug delivery system for managing surgical and para-surgical diseases.
